The Trek:

Three-person teams will follow a scenic route consisting of three legs:

1. a 2-kilometer ski on forest trails
2. snowshoeing with a "twist"—across open fields
3. a "mitten-pin" pursuit through wooded ravines

Trek the route as an Altogether Team, Relay Team, or Solo Adventurer. Teams are encouraged to include a child. The event will be adapted to the prevailing weather conditions: For example, the skiing leg could be changed to a trek on skates, if the ice is great.

A fun family experience:

The last leg of the event will bring participants together for a mitten-pin search. Teams can choose short or long treks to retrieve pins and bring them back to the Outing Club hut.

All ages and skill levels are encouraged to participate. Those who have been part of the BOC Winter Sports School Program may use their newfound skills with their families!
